§ 6 Board of Directors

In the event a Board member is prevented from serving, a deputy Board member takes his or her place on that occasion. In the event that the Vice President would also have to step down prior to the expiration of his/her term, an Extraordinary Meeting would take place to elect a new President until the following Annual Meeting. In the event a regular member of the Board steps down from the Board prior to the expiration of the term, a deputy Board member would assume the position vacated.

Presentation of Club Officers – Existing and Proposed

Johan Samuelsson - President
